which any artist might be proud:

Cornelius Van Vliet was born in Rot terdam, Holland, on September 1, 1886. Beginning with his sixth year, his father had him instructed in violin and piano. At nine years of age his whole
interest centered in the cello, in the interest centered the cello, in the master, so that today there are but
few who may be counted his rivals. At the age of twelve he often ap peared as soloist in the larger cities of Holland.
His travels began in October, 1903, when but seventeen years old he became solo 'cellist of the Philharmonic Orehestra of Leipzig under Hans Winderstein. In Leipzig, as well as on many concert tours of the orchestra, Van Vliet proved a brilliant success. His reputation as an artist soon spread so that Oscar Nebdal, director of the Philharmonic Orchestra of Prague, engagedh im . With this orchestra Van Vliet made numerous concert tours through Bohemia Poland and Russia, always with the same suc cess.
After a brilliant season in Pawlowsk near St. Petersburg, Van Vliet stayed for a time in Helsingfors, the capital of Finland, as solo 'cellist of the Philharmonic Orchestra
He gave up this position in October 1905, to become the first solo 'cellist
of the Kaim Orchestra in Munich. Gerof the Kaim Orchestra in Munich, Ger-
