Besides giving out the class work cards which are to be presented to the advisors the registration cards and the credit cards which are kept in the registrar's office at all times will also be given out. A signed notice of the withdrawal of these credit cards must be left by the student.

A feature of the registration for this year seems to be the fact that after having completed the compulsory rhetoric and drill and the regular

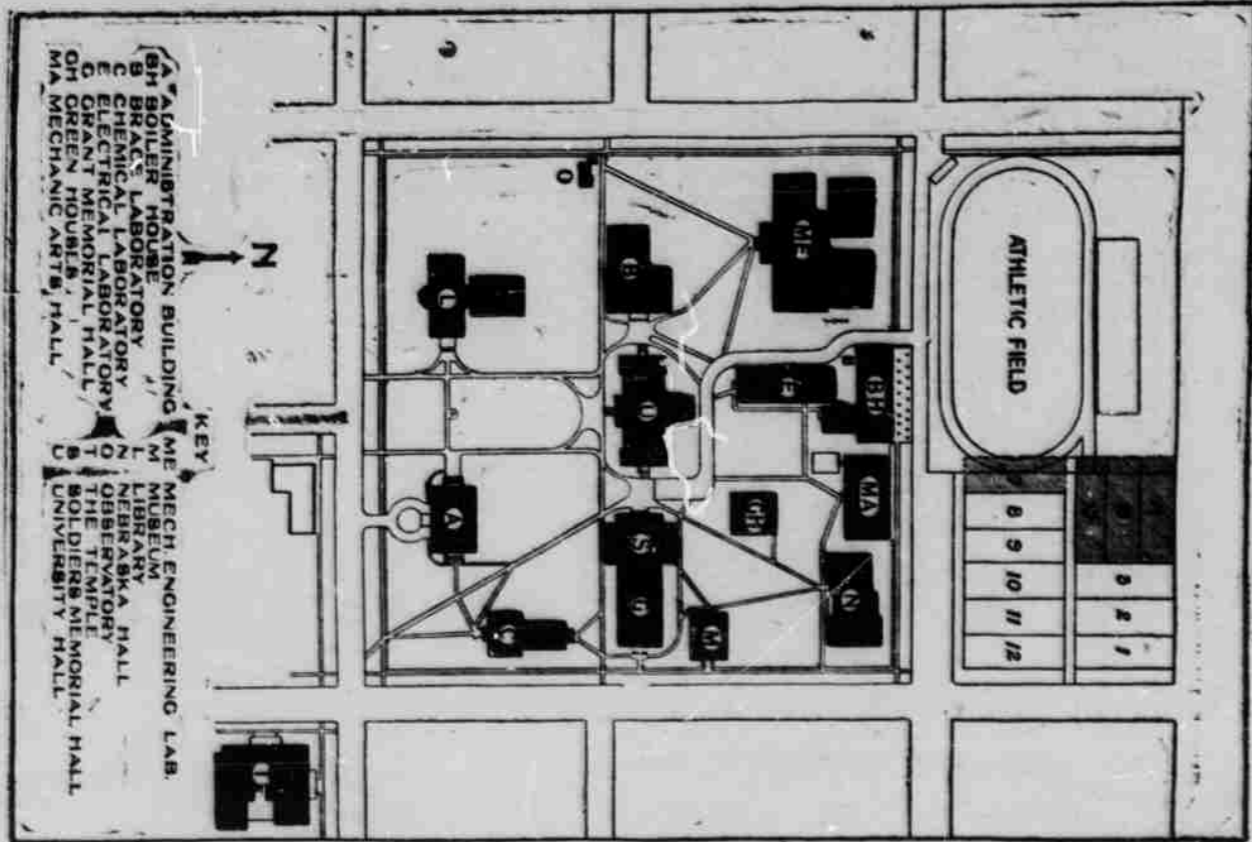
group requirements the student may forget the old system of majors and minors and in turn concentrate on some one subject to the extent of sixteen hours. He may of course major and minor if he so sees fit.

intensely fascinating. Here is the prophecy:

"This is a revelation of events of a universal character which must shortly come to pass. Their spiritual outlines are now before my eyes. I see, floating upon the surface of the sea of human fate, the huge silhouette of a nude woman. She is—with her beauty, her poise, her smile, her jewels—a super Venus.

Her breath, reeking of sordid transactions, her voice of metallic character like gold, and her look of greed are so much poison to the nations who fall victims to her charms.

"And behold, she has three gigantic arms with three torches of universal corruption in her hand.

"The first torch represents the flame of war, that the beautiful courtesan
