The following are the places of registration:

First Ward—A precinct, Windsor Hotel, Eleventh and Q streets; B precinct, 816 North Tenth street; C precinct, Moseley's Hall, Twelfth and Belmont streets.

Second Ward—A precinct, County Court House, Tenth and K streets; B precinct, 321 South Ninth street; C precinct, Lebsock's Hall, Fourth and F streets.

Third Ward—A precinct, Central Hotel, 1325 P street; B precinct, 1620 O street; C precinct, 2042 O street.

Fourth Ward—A precinct, 1226 N street; B precinct, A. B. A. Auto Company, Fifteenth and N streets; C precinct, 1945 J street.

Fifth Ward—A precinct, Fire Engine House, 1225 F street; B precinct, 1605 South Seventeenth street; C precinct, Arenson's store, Fourteenth and South streets.

Sixth Ward—A precinct, Fire Engine House, Twenty-third and O streets; B precinct, 2643 Randolph street; C precinct, 1715 South Twenty-fifth street.

Seventh Ward—A precinct, 1505 North Twenty-seventh street; B precinct, 2639 W street; C precinct, Sunderland's Garage, 2709 S street.

Qualifications to vote

On the question as to who may vote an attorney of Lincoln says:

"Voters that are students at the University and that now consider Lincoln their home are entitled to vote. This is true even if a person is uncertain and undecided as to his future home or future course or place of residence upon the completion of his University course. Six months in the state, ninety days in the city and ten days in the precinct are the important factors. The registration day is next Saturday, and the city election on May 4."
