 Varsity football at Oklahoma and Haskell won his first "O" when a yearling.
 He returned to the University in 1917 and suffered a dislocated vertebrae in his neck the first week of practice. He was forced to withdraw from school on account of his injury and for two years Haskell was an invalid. In 1919 he returned to the Sooner colors and won his second letter at the end of that year.
 Last season Haskell was first string end with the Missouri Valley conference championship eleven from Soonerland and was mentioned on almost every all-Valley selection made by sport writers throughout the Valley. He was elected to lead the Sooners their second year in the Valley and his best season eligible for Oklahoma football.
 Haskell is a born fighter. Although weighing but 165 pounds he is one of

the most dependable defense ends Ben G. Owen, director of Sooner athletics ever produced. His ability to catch forward passes marks him as particularly adapted to Owen football since the veteran coach of the Valley is one of the strongest adherents of the aerial game in football.
