WORKOUTS BEGIN
IN HUSKER CAMP**

Dawson to Issue First Call for
Pigskin Candidates Next
Week—Team Badly
Shattered.

TRACK CUTS DOWN TEAM

Stars on 1922 Squad Either Absent or Out on Cinders—
Freshman Candidates Out.

Spring football practise will start in earnest next week, weather permitting, in the Nebraska camp according to announcement by Head Coach Dawson. The practise will take the form of outdoor workouts.

Dawson is confronted with two handicaps when he takes the 1923 candidates out on the field to begin rounding out a team for next year.

His first problem is to figure out some way that the men who are showing up well in the track and gridiron sports may have time enough to get plenty of training for both sports without interference.

His other problem is well known over the campus and seems well nigh insurmountable. All the followers of the Nebraska's football team are familiar with the devastating effects of graduation and ineligibility on next year's team and on top of this, the coach will be hindered by the lack of a suitable field for practise. The old athletic field will not be available because of the construction of the stadium.

Captain Verne Lowellen is needed on the baseball squad, track, and with his football mates of next year. How "Lew" is to split up his time is a mystery.

Other members of last year's football team available for next year are Bassett and Berquist, both of whom are working with the weights. Ced Hartman, trying for Hartley's place at fullback, is throwing the discus. Dave Noble is using his speed on the dashes. McAlister, Nixon, and Hubka of last year's squad are all working on Coach Schulte's track aggregation. Of the freshmen who showed up well on the gridiron last fall, Meyers, Rhoades, and Locke are showing up on the cinders and field events.

This leave Coach Dawson the two Dewitz brothers as his only old men to appear regularly for spring practise. This is a compliment on the versatility of Husker athletes but leaves the head coach face to face with a big problem to conquer.

Lloyd Dillon, M. E., mid-year class of '23, has accepted a position with the Denver Gas and Electric company.

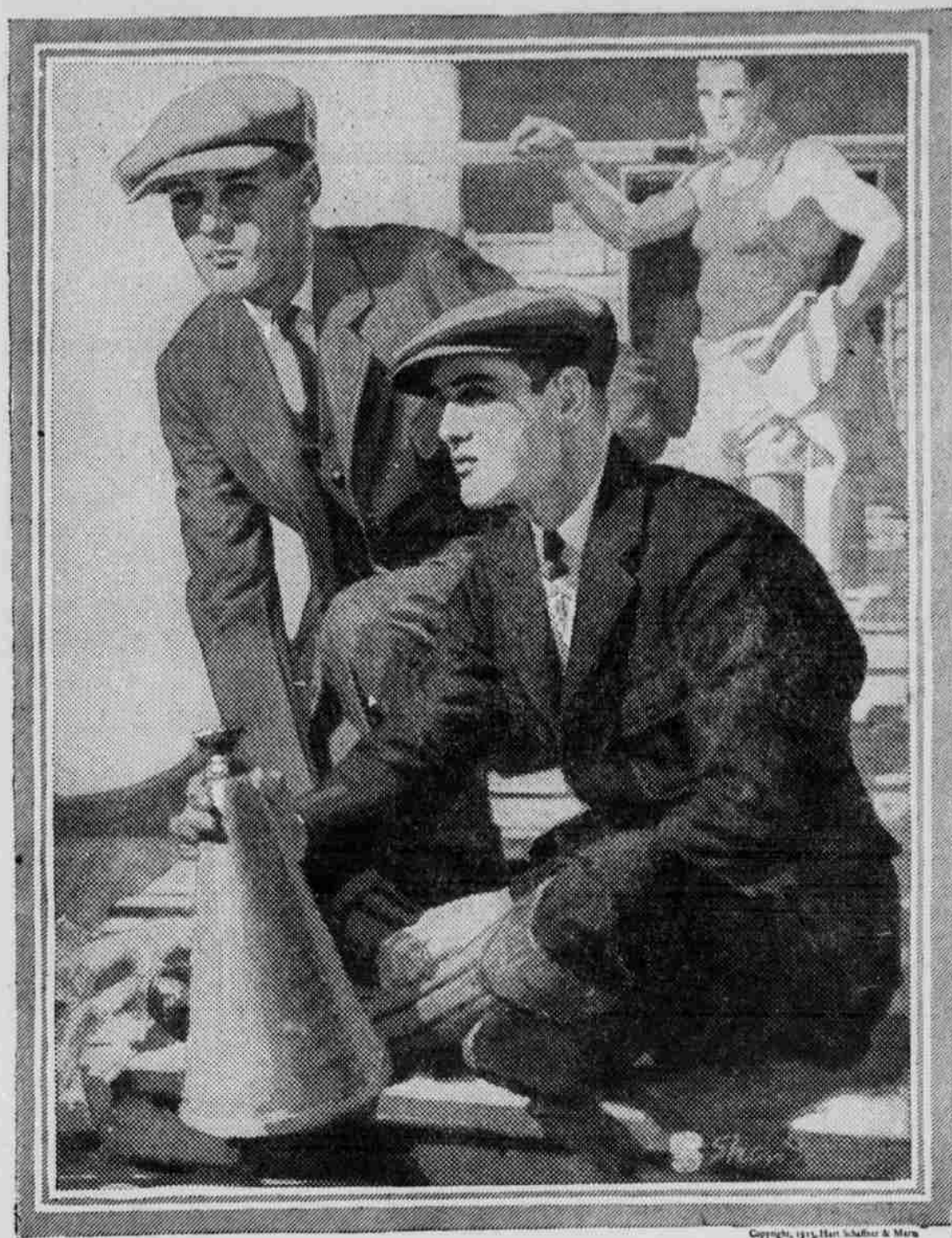
