The films shown will include features from over the state. University scenes, and comedies. Many of these pictures have never before been seen by University students. This will give them some new ideas about the old campus.

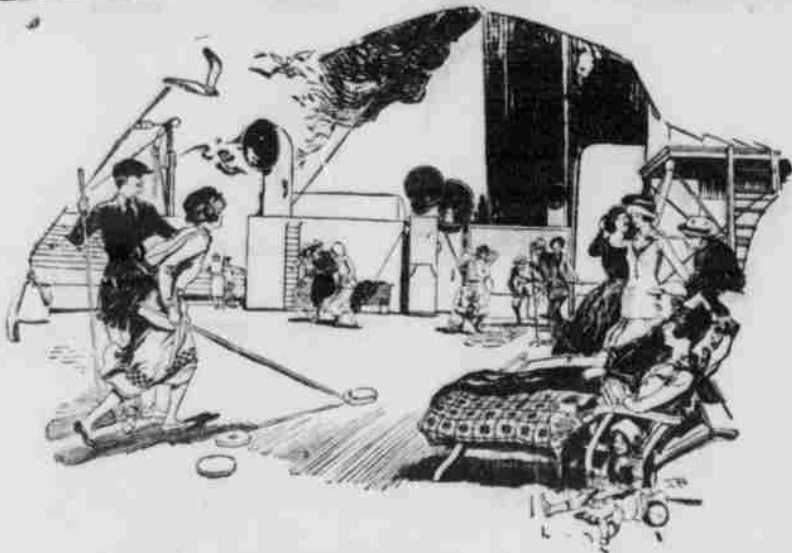
