About 400 applications for work
 have been received from men
 students, mainly freshmen from out
 of the city, by the Student Employ-
 ment Bureau, and 125 have already
 been placed. Lincoln people who
 have any kind of work for students
 are asked by Bennett S. Martin, em-
 ployment secretary, to list it imme-
 diately, because many men cannot

attend the University unless they se-
 cure part-time work. Places where
 men can work for board and room,
 or its equivalent in money, are par-
 ticularly desired. Last year 1200
 men placed by the bureau received
 a total income of \$40,000.

James W. Kinsinger, a recent

practicing in Lincoln, has been ap-
 pointed assistant in charge of the
 class in quasi-contracts.

Books costing \$16,700, received
 by the Regents' book store are ready
 for sale to students. The store han-
 dles all the books required in the Un-

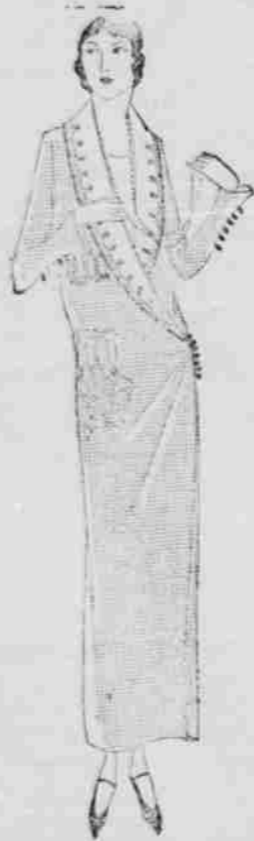

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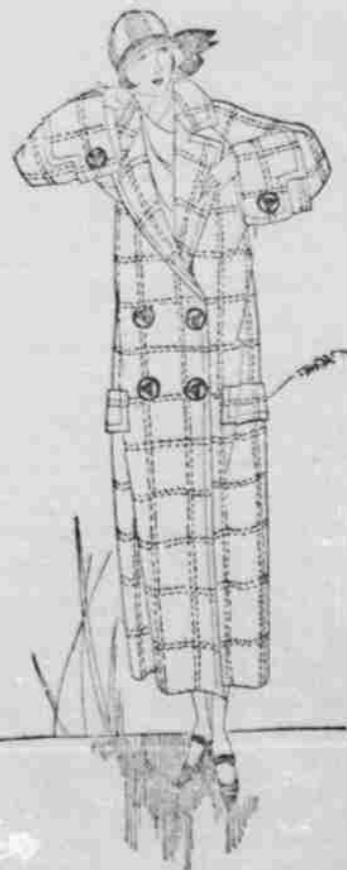
