The World Fellowship Group, of which Dr. Aitken was a member, was composed of university officials, social workers, ministers, and business "While America is not officially represented in the League of Nations, our influence is felt very strongly," said Dr. Aitken.

Those in the party were unanimous study European conditions.

Members of the party heard speakers represent every point of view in the important European countries. In addition, many members of the party made personal investigations of conditions among the common people.

The conclusion that the German people as a whole should be freed from responsibility for the war and that every effort should be made to enable them to get back to normal conditions was reached by the group.

Considerable time was spent investigating the stories of atrocities committed by German soldiers, which were current in this country during the war, and nearly all of them were found to be without foundation.


