the college or year of the applicant. Each ticket entitled the holder to prompt attention during the hour and day of registration week mentioned on it. In this way the number of students to be accommodated at any one time was limited. This system also did away with the last minute rush to register.

Any undergraduate student who did not register at the time assigned to him would be unable to register that week and was forced to register in the next week and pay the late registration fee of three dollars. Any change in registration was treated the same way unless the student was forced to change because of a failure or condition in the subject carried in the first semester.

Four students were running in the campaign for editor-in-chief of The Daily Nebraskan, two were applying for the position of managing editor, and four for the position of associate editors, with two positions to be filled. The ballots were so constructed that it was possible for the voter to express his first choice and his second choice for every office.

The Athletic Board had approved the football schedule for 1915 that had been worked out. The schedule called for games in Lincoln with Drake, Kansas Aggies, Notre Dame, Wesleyan, and Iowa. Games with Ames and the University of Kansas to be played on their fields had also been scheduled. The one open date was to be filled with a game played in Lincoln with Washburn.
