Ten Years Ago

The Student Activities office in the basement of the Administration Building arranged for new departments. The business desks of the University publications, including The Daily Nebraskan, the Awgwan and the Cornhusker, were put there. The Rhodes scholar from Nebraska, chosen at a meeting of the State Committee held in Chancellor Av-

ery's office, was Paul B. Means of Orleans. Reductions were made in the sources of income of the 1916 Cornhusker to such an extent that the net profit of the book was introduced over \$600. While the sale of the book remained at \$3.00, the actual cost of the Cornhusker to almost every student was reduced from fifty cents to two dollars and this was where it was needed most.

In an effort to rid the fraternity section of the University of Illinois of all business places, 17 fraternities recently adopted a resolution to boycott all of the existing unwanted business places.

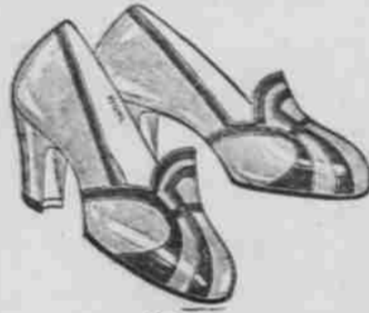
