115 Nebraska Alumni Hold Interesting Meeting at San Francisco; Hunter, '05, Presides

Nebraska Alumni in San Francisco held a meeting November 5 with 115 present. Many others sent in telegrams saying that they would like to be at the meeting. One wireless message was received.

Fred M. Hunter, '05, now superintendent of the Oakland schools presided at the meeting. Films showing the commencement exercises, campus activities and some of the Faculty

and older characters on the campus were enthusiastically received. J. C. Stevens of Portland, Oregon, presented Dean Oscar Van Pelt Stout, former University of Nebraska professor in the College of Engineering with a leather-bound book of letters, entitled "Words of Appreciation."

On the title page of the book were the words "To Oscar Van Pelt Stout, Teacher, Councilor, Friend, whose sphere of influence is ever broadening.
