

# HUSKERS MEET SOONERS TODAY

Ten Men Make One of Stiffest Trips on Schedule; Play Valley Leaders

Coach Black and his Nebraska basketball squad left Thursday afternoon for Oklahoma where the Scarlet and Cream players will meet the Oklahoma Sooners today and the Oklahoma Aggies tomorrow evening.

The southern invasion is one of the most important trips on the Cornhusker schedule, for two hard games will be on tap for the Nebraska cagers. The Oklahoma Sooners, the Cornhusker foe for this afternoon, are leading the Valley teams in the race for the Missouri Valley Championship. The Sooner quintet has not been defeated this year in Valley games and has an aggregation that will furnish stiff opposition for the Husker basketeers.

Ten varsity cagers, Coach Charles Black, and the student manager left for Soonerland on the Burlington at 1:45 o'clock yesterday afternoon. The men who made the trip are Captain Clark Smaha, Ted Page, Roy Anderson, Elmer Holm, Kenneth Othmer, John Brown, Tom Elliott, Merritt Klepser, Phil Gerelick and Vint Lawson.

Haskell has been athletic mentor at the Kansas City, Kansas, high school and is considered one of the most successful and capable baseball experts in the state.

The Kansas Jayhawkers, rejuvenated after defeating the Mizou Tigers at Columbia, took the count of the Hillyard Pine-O-Cides, three times national A. A. U. champions, by a victorious 30 to 27 score.

Jake Duabert, swimming coach at Iowa State has a tank find in Roger Holm, freshman from Wells, Minnesota. With the exception of Johnnie Meismuller, Holm is considered the fastest man who has ever entered the water of the Iowa State swimming pool. Although he is only a freshman,

Holm has never been beaten by a varsity swimmer.

Captain Clark Smaha, Cornhusker forward, is up among the first five for high scoring honors in the Missouri Valley. If Clark keeps hitting the pace he has been setting in the last three games, he should finish up among the high pointers of the Valley. Earl Elliott, the Ames flash, still continues to lead the Valley scorers for high-point honors.

With nine lettermen reporting for workouts each night and a number of promising candidates from last year's Valley champion freshman team, prospects for a good track team look favorable at the University of Kansas. Due to the new track, Kansas runners are at work earlier than ever before and this fact may help Dr. H. J. Huff produce a strong team.
