GATHER FOR MEET

sophomores Krause and Fleming on whose success in the barrier events depends much of Nebraska's chances of holding the title.

Captain Bobby Stephens' sure first place in the broad jump has faded away into oblivion between his series of injuries and unexpected improvements in other valley jumpers. Stephens has been carefully nursed along the last two weeks, every effort being made to get him into shape for the valley championships, but not until he jumps will his condition really be known.

Broad Jumpers are Numerous
On the other hand Mullins of Oklahoma, his team-mate Stalker, McInerney of Kansas, and Lancaster of Missouri, all considered 22 foot jumpers, have sprung loose in the last two weeks to make better marks than Stephens' leap of 23 feet 6

inches early in the spring which set a new valley indoor record. Besides these stars, Andrews of Nebraska must be considered a chance of ending in the scoring although he has not yet bettered 23 feet.

Last year high jumpers were practically nil. Anderson of Oklahoma was the only man able to get over six feet last year and that was his limit. He is back this year but will be pushed by Brunk and Carle, the two Drake high jumpers who have been leaping around the 6 foot 2 mark with distressing regularity for Oklahoma's chances. There may be other good jumpers in the valley but these are enough to make the contest interesting.

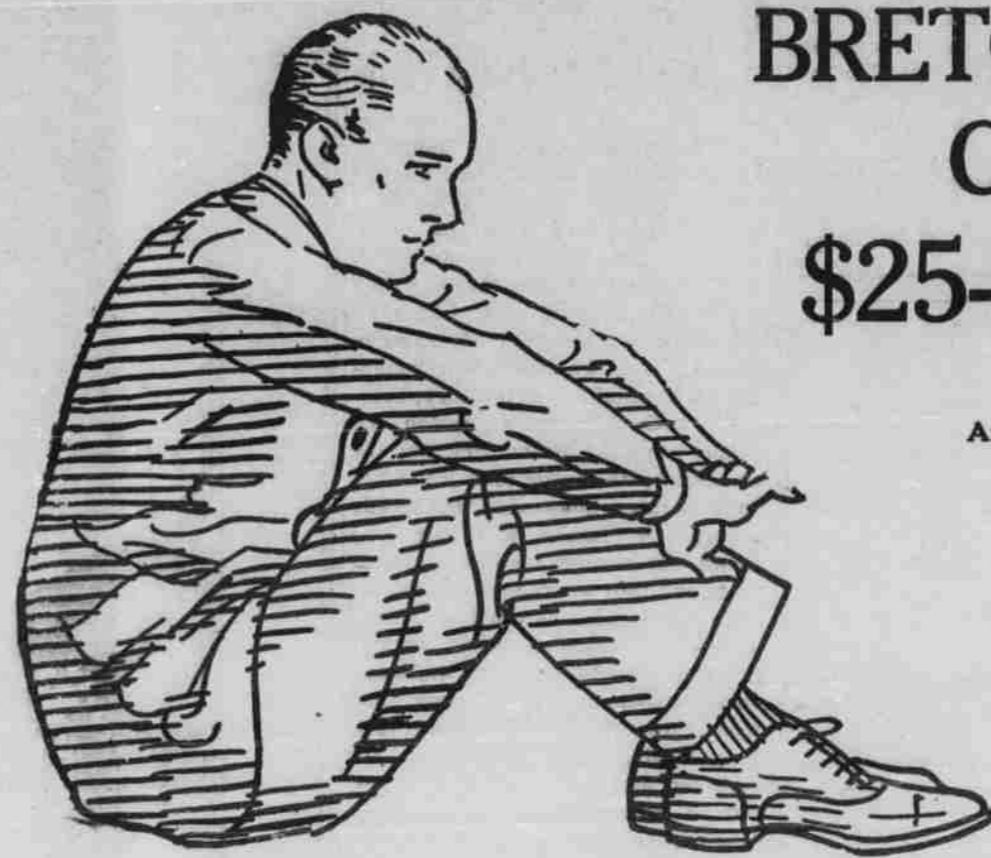
Wirsig Will Have Competition
With the exception of "Choppy" Rhodes, who tied for second place last year, all the pole vaulters who pushed Frank Wirsig to set a new record last year will be back to try again Saturday. If Wirsig is "right" he will have a good chance of bettering his own valley record. If he isn't he is likely to find himself well down in the list of place winners.

Drake of Oklahoma has been making 12 feet 6 inches consistently all season and his team-mate Potts was one of the leading vaulters in the valley last year. Lancaster of Missouri, Cash of Kansas, and others are set to push the 13-foot mark.

Rinefort is Weight Star
Weight men present a wonderful array of talent and are expected to better both shot put and discus records if the weather is favorable. Rinefort of Grinnell, Thornhill of

Kansas, Ashburn, Hurd, Durisch, and Pospisil of Nebraska, McAnnelly and Brown of Missouri and Larid and Meeter of Grinnell furnish a flashy bunch of weight men.

Both mile and half-mile relay teams hold promise of sensational battles. Nebraska won both last year and has the same team left for the mile relay this year as won it last year although this quartet has failed to function successfully as yet this year. Kansas is favored in the shorter relay with Oklahoma Aggies counting themselves likely winners of the mile relay.
