Great Variety Shown in Designs  
Many "patchwork" shawls were composed of scrolls and cones cut from narrow strips woven for that purpose, and fitted together in a great variety of designs. Not all the shawls were loom-woven. Often a ground of plain wool was covered with needlework, and a clever embroiderer could produce the effect of

loom-work. Again, one shawl might show both weaving and embroidery. In the eighteenth century, English officers in India began to send home these shawls, and soon England and France became steady markets. The fashions of 1820 and 1833, the outcome of the Franco-Prussian war and the change in fashions caused a decline, and shawl-weaving practically died out years ago.  
Great shawl industries grew up in Lyons, France, and in Paisley, Scotland. In these industries the machine-loom imitated with great effectiveness the patterns and coloring of the hand-woven Kashmir. At its height, Paisley produced five million dollars' worth of shawls annually. The industry finally died out. In its last phase, Paisley shawls were printed in gay colors on wool or cotton.

**Massachusetts Institute of Technology School of Chemical Engineering Practice**  
INDIVIDUAL and practical training at five industrial plants are important features of the Graduate Course in Chemical Engineering Practice. Field work is carried out at Bangor, Me.; Boston, Mass., Buffalo, N. Y., and Baysonne, N. J.; in plants producing sulphite and soda pulp, paper, caustic soda, chlorine, heavy acids and salts, sugar, coke, gas, steel, petroleum and other chemical products.  
The more important operations of Chemical Engineering, as practiced by the plant, processes, are studied systematically by tests and experiments on actual plant apparatus, thus fixing in the student's mind the principles of Chemical Engineering and correlating these principles with practice.  
The work is non-communitive and independent of plant control, the whole attention of the students being directed to study and experimentation.  
Registration is limited, as students study and experiment in small groups and receive individual instruction by resident members of the Institute's Faculty.  
Admission requires adequate preparation in chemistry and engineering. Able students can complete the requirements for the Master of Science degree in one and a half years.
