

JAYHAWKS ANTICIPATE STIFF HUSKER BATTLE

Coach Lindsey Assigns Brisk Drills Preparing for Nebraska Game.

LAWRENCE, Kan. — Putting condition and fight into the Jayhawker football team for its thirty-ninth annual meeting with the Nebraska Cornhuskers here Saturday afternoon was occupying more attention from the University of Kansas coaches this week than anything else. Of course, Coach Lindsey and his staff is planning some new plays for the Nebraska invasion, which he hopes will give the homecoming crowd some thrills in the way of substantial Jayhawker gains, but his main worry seems to be over getting his squad in shape to play a full game of tough football.

"The team's condition has not been first class yet this season," Coach Lindsey said upon return home from the Kansas victory of 26 to 0 over Iowa State, "and we are going to give the boys plenty of work this week to see if we can't do something about that. Nebraska plays a rugged type of football, always has, and always has been good at it. The Cornhuskers have a great defense and an offense that is clicking nicely, so there is no reason to expect other than a hard battle this week."

K. U. Campus Aroused.

While the coaches are not seeing things in too rosy a light this week the campus fans are all enthusiastic over the Kansas chances against Nebraska this year due to the showing of the team at Iowa State.

Functioning of the line and the backfield also displayed good blocking and tackling against Iowa State, and the ball carrying of Schaake, Beach, Dumm and Weaver, was effective for many long gains.

Kansas and Nebraska will go into the game with the lines about even in weight, and with Kansas carrying a slight edge in the backfield as to weight, but the Huskers having an edge in speed.

The game will have a big bearing on the Big Six championship race in which Nebraska is out to retain the title gained in 1931. The Huskers have not lost a conference game in two years thus far and have a victory over Iowa State thus far this season. Kansas has lost to Oklahoma this fall and defeated Iowa State so must win Saturday from Nebraska if any hope of a conference title is to remain for the Jayhawkers.

The game starts here Saturday at 2 p. m. Tickets are selling for \$2.75 for reserved seats, including tax; and at \$1.50 including tax for unreserved seats which go on sale at the gate at noon the day of the game.

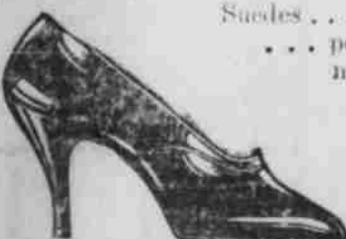
