

# SCARLET FIVE TAKE DAKOTA BASKETEERS IN SATURDAY GAME

## Bud Parsons Leads Tossers To Third Basketball Victory of Year.

Bud Parsons went on a scoring spree Saturday night to lead Nebraska to a 34-25 victory over South Dakota on the coliseum floor. The Huskers were out in front 15-11 at the intermission and remained in the lead throughout the entire second half. It was the third triumph of the season for the Huskers.

With the count 4-3 in favor of

the Scarlet tossers at the end of nine and one-half minutes, Coach Browne sent Parsons into the lineup and Bud proceeded to stretch the advantage. He collected three field goals before the half ended.

At the start of the second half Mason contributed a setup to the cause but baskets by Buck and Olson reduced the margin to two points. Parsons started hitting the hoop again, however, and added seven points more to the Husker total. Nebraska was never in serious danger in the last half.

George Sauer turned in a good game at guard as well as bombarding the hoop for eight markers. Coach Browne used ten flippers during the melee.

# MISSOURI TIGERS DEFEAT OKLAHOMA IN BIG SIX GAME

## Kansas U Tie Sooners in Conference as Latter Loses Mix.

Oklahoma's defeat at the hands of the Missouri Tigers at Columbia Friday night by a 40 to 30 score has again set the Sooners back into a tie with the Kansas five in the Big Six cage race. Each of the teams has won five and lost two games in conference competition.

In the Friday game the Sooners were attempting to break the jinx which has gone with them on all their trips, but the Missourians piled up an early lead and succeeded in holding to it to gain the ten point victory. At one stage of the game the Columbia crew held a 37 to 17 advantage and thus found it comparatively easy to coast to victory. The Norman has yet to play Iowa State at Norman, and Kansas and Nebraska on the Lawrence and Lincoln courts. Thus the Sooner team certainly will find it necessary to win on foreign courts in order to win the pennant for Kansas is playing Iowa State and Oklahoma at Lawrence and Kansas State at Manhattan. Altho Oklahoma defeated Kansas 25 to 23 at Norman the odds at present appear against Coach McDermott's men in the Kansas-Oklahoma game which in all probability is to decide the championship.

Missouri also must be coped with in the championship picture, for if a loss is incurred by either of the two leaders Missouri will be in a tie with the team losing with four wins and three losses. The Tigers play Nebraska this Saturday evening on the Coliseum floor. Early in the season the Missou-

rians trimmed the Huskers 37 to 33 at Columbia, and since Coach Edwards men are also notoriously unsuccessful on foreign courts Coach Browne's men appear to have at least an even chance to upset the Tigers.
