Trimbles Collects Three Hits For Knights; Season Closes Monday.

With Boy Joyce setting fifteen of the enemy down in their seats with strike-outs registered against them, Nebraska avenged a double-loss to Iowa State college earlier in the week by swamping Concordia Teachers college...
