Mizzou's Bob Steuber Counts Twenty Points Against Ames

Long-striding Bob Steuber, the Missouri All-American halfback candidate, moved into a solid lead for the national scoring title last week by counting 20 points against Iowa State.

Steuber counted three touchdowns against the Cyclones and converted after two of them to compile his total. Frankie Sinkwich, an All-American last year, continued his bid for 1942 laurels by scoring three touchdowns to move into runnerup position behind Steuber.

Top individual performance last week was turned in by Jim Secrest, University of Rochester halfback. Secrest scampered to five touchdowns to move into fourth place in national scoring.

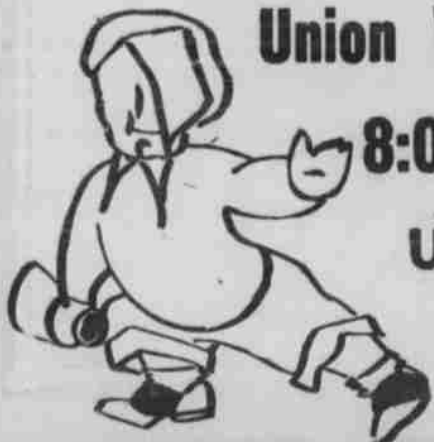
