Government **Hires More** Uni Womer

College women have increase ing opportunities for employment in government, and now practically 70 per cent of all new appointees are women.

The recruitment of several thousand college women under examinations for junior professional assistant has had a profound affect, in the view of Donald C. Stone, assistant director of the Budget Bureau. Rapid promotions in many cases led him to relect: "My fear is that with the dearth of adequately trained persons, promotion of many of these young employees to high positions has come too rapidly. In any event, there is a desperate search going on by all agencies for persons quali-fied for administrative work of all grades from juniors to heads of bureaus and divisions."

Of 1,900 war occupations, 1,-468 are listed by the Social Security Board as suitable for women. An additional 276 are listed as partially suitable.
