## UN Faces Iowa In Cage Opener

With only a little more than a week of practice behind them, the 1943 Husker basketball squad leaves tomorrow on a three game trip against three of the toughest teams on this year's roster—University of Iowa, DePaul university, and the Golden Gophers of Minnesota. Faced by the same manpower shortage experienced in football, Coach Ad Lewandowski is anything but optimistic about the season's prospects.

### Huskers Have Chance.

Friday night, the Huskers meet Iowa in Iowa City. "Pops" Harrison, Iowa coach, has not a single veteran on his squad, and no holdovers from last year's frosh squad. Against this team as untried as Nebraska, the Huskers have probably their only chance for a win out of the first three games. Minnesota also starts from scratch having lost all ten lettermen. Bill Muske and Duane Baglien look like the biggest threats on the Gopher team. The Gophers, however, have a good crop of 17 year olds and a number of navy men to bolster their squad. Minnesota, as usual, looks good, too good for the inexperienced Huskers. DePaul university in Chicago always has a good basketball turnout, and this year is no exception from re-

ports of the large squad working out for the Husker game.

Allen Artman, only returning UN letterman, is slated for a forward berth in these first games. Tom Dworak and Eldon Potter have been working out on the tentative first team for the other forward position. Don Barry, 6-4 tall man on the team, will probably start as center. "Gus" Eager, former Lincoln high hotshot, Melvin Sherman, and George Lucas will work the guard positions.

Lewandowski said that the boys haven't worked together enough to have any more than a semblance of a team as yet, but he expects them to get good experience in the season openers. "We hope to get better and make a good showing as the season advances," he said.

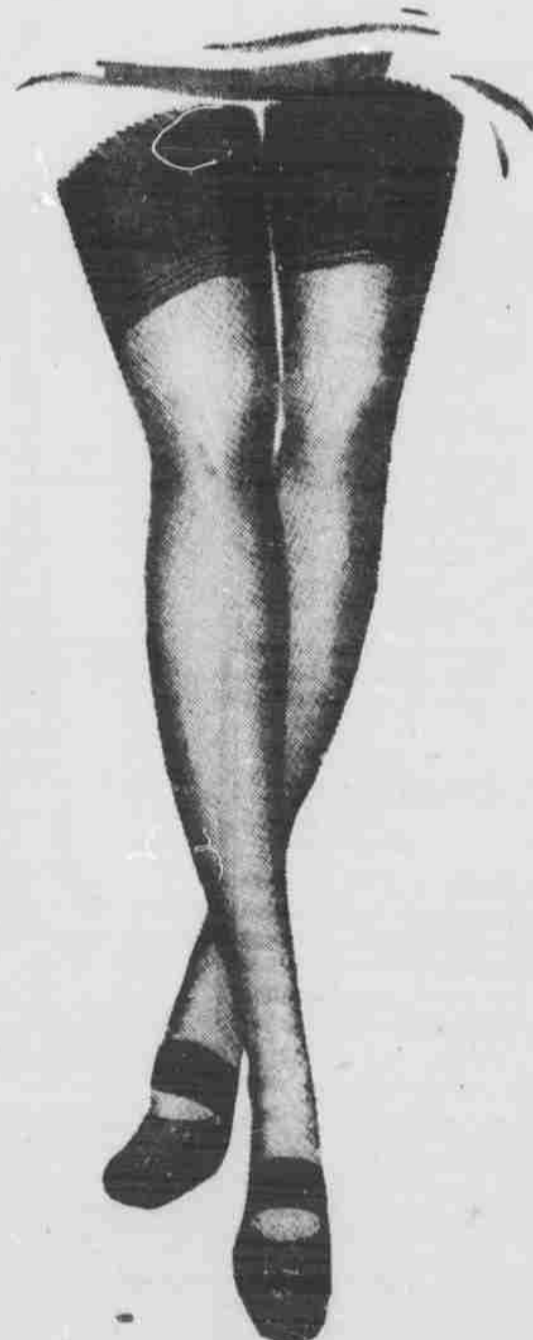
