Rules and pairings of the handball and table tennis tournaments are as follows:

- Table tennis rules:
1. All games must be played between Nov. 20 and Nov. 30.
  2. Five men will represent each house in singles matches.
  3. The team winning 3 out of 5 matches will be the victor in each pairing.
  4. Games may be played at any place desirable to the participating teams. The Student Union will facilitate a number of the matches.
  5. All results must be reported to Gordon Ehlers at the ATO house not later than Nov. 30.

Information concerning the handball tournament:

1. All games must be played between Nov. 20 and 30.
2. Each house will be represented by three men.

3. Team winning two out of three singles matches will be victor in each pairing.
4. Gloves and handballs can be checked out from the cage in the coliseum any afternoon between 2 and 4 o'clock in the afternoon.
5. All results must be turned

in not later than Nov. 30 to Gordon Ehlers at the ATO house. play must be made by the opposing houses. All participants will be under the same rulings concerning scholastic standing as were published for touch football.

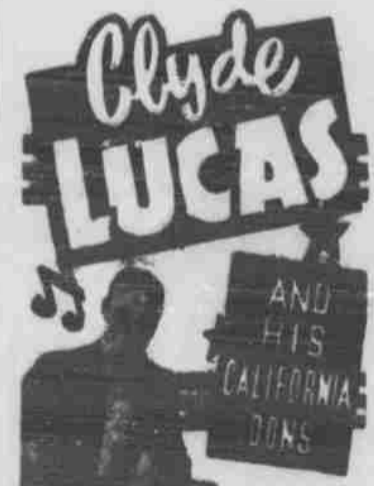
