done about the matter of rejuvenation of the tradition of rigorous and complicated final exams by the Board of Regents or by any other influential factor of this institution.

Tradition is usually rather hard to break away from and for this institution it appears to be terrifically difficult. It has followed the same rut for a long time, so I hear. I have been in attendance at this university for only one year so it is perfectly obvious that I am not an age-old and experienced person but from the little experience that I have had here I have noted one thing in particular and that is that some one seems to be trying their level best to modernize this school. That is to say, several holes have been dug in the campus and a lot of manure has been spread around trying to grow some grass, but I have noted nothing that has been done to modernize the methods of instruction and the methods of finding out what

the student has gotten out of all the instruction he or she may have been exposed to.

Regardless of how beneficial to the student body the proposed policy of final exams may be, I doubt that the faculty can be convinced that the average student can learn a few things without going through hell and high water and trying to memorize a book overnight. It is a shame that the Board of Regents and the faculty do not appreciate the fact that a lot learned quickly is often forgotten just as quickly.

Probably not much can be done to bring recognition to this proposed policy unless enough people get behind it. Why not make the proposal a platform and push the platform? If enough force is applied something will eventually give and lets hope that it is the Board of Regents and any other influential body that may be of some help.
