Regardless of how beneficial to the student body the proposed policy of final exams may be, I doubt that the faculty can be convinced that the average student can learn a few things without going through hell and high water and trying to memorize a book overnight. It is a shame that the Board of Regents and the faculty do not appreciate the fact that a lot learned quickly is often forgotten just as quickly.

Probably not much can be done to bring recognition to this proposed policy unless enough people get behind it. Why not make the proposal a platform and push the platform? If enough force is applied something will eventually give and lets hope that it is the Board of Regents and any other influential body that may be of some help. JOE BECKER
