

Large Radio Class Enrollment Causes These Happy Smiles

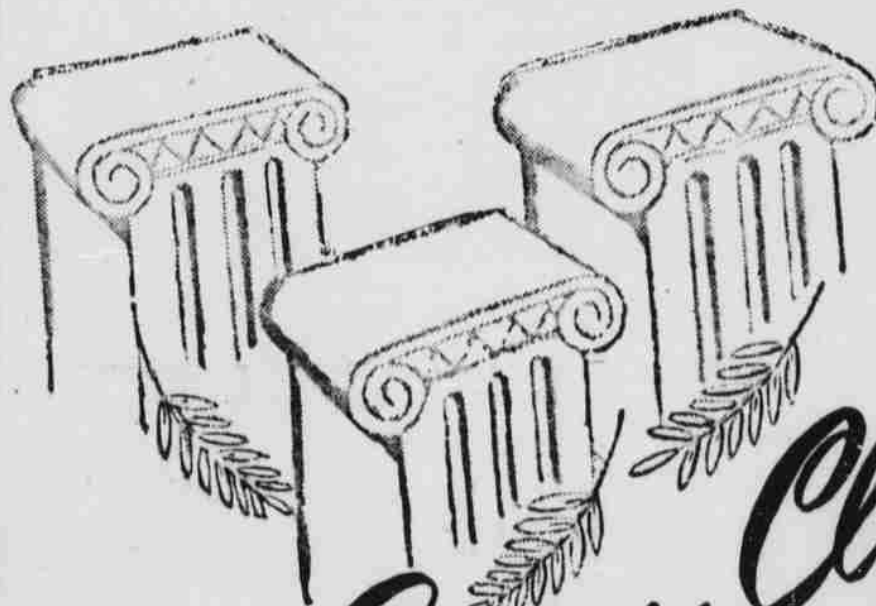
