

# Robert B. Crosby Will Speak At Federalist Convo Thursday

Lieutenant Governor Robert B. Crosby will be the speaker at a university convocation sponsored by the university's chapter of Student Federalists, Thursday at 3 p. m. in the Union ballroom.

"A Nebraska Approach to World Government" will be discussed by the newly elected Lieutenant Governor, a former member of the Unicameral.

### Speaks to Republicans

Recently speaking before a meeting of the Young Republicans, Lt. Gov. Crosby won statewide acclaim for the views he expressed concerning representative government. A veteran of the past war, he has suggested progressive legislation in many fields, even advocating the abolition of the office he now holds, claiming it is "useless" and that abolition of it would save taxpayers money.

When asked whether he believes that the United Nations as now constituted is capable of preserving lasting peace, he answered "No." He thinks further that the United States should make the goal of world government the central core of our foreign policy.

Believing that world government can best be achieved by ultimately converting the United Nations into a Federal World Government, Lt. Gov. Crosby

suggests the gradual strengthening of the United Nations and working along the outlines of Article 109 of the UN's Charter, which sets provisions for the calling of a new constitutional convention.

This is the first of a series of monthly convocations with popular and well known speakers that the Student Federalists are planning, according to Milton Field, program director for the organization. He also stated that an outstanding feature of Crosby's talk would be the question period at the end that will provide students with an opportunity to ask him any questions that they might have concerning his talk.

# ROTC Band Selections Announced
