

Five Seniors Will Present Solo Concert

Students Perform With Orchestra

Five seniors will perform with the University Orchestra under Emanuel Wishnow's direction Tuesday at 7:30 p. m. in the Union Ballroom, presenting a work for orchestra and soloist. Elected by the senior class of the school of music, the soloists are Mary Alice Peterson, organist, Richard Koupal, tenor, Margaret Modlin, trumpet, Helen Laird, contralto and Marilyn Nelson, pianist.

Mr. Koupal, who sang the lead in this year's production of "Pagliacci" and who was heard as oratorio soloist in a number of performances before the war, will sing the "Flower Song" from Bizet's "Carmen." Also an oratorio soloist and a lead in "Cavalleria Rusticana," Miss Laird will sing songs by Strauss and Marx.

Handel.

Miss Peterson, who has played form the organ console at a number of university musical productions, will play two movements from Handel's "Concerto in D minor." She is organist at Vine Congregational church. Miss Modlin holds the first trumpet chair in the ROTC Varsity band and was a soloist at the band's mid-winter symphonic concert. She will play a Haydn concerto with the orchestra. Miss Nelson, who has served as piano accompanist for numerous recitals and presentations, will close the program with the final movement of Grieg's A minor concerto.

The concert, an annual affair, is open free to students and the general public. The complete program is:

Henry Lee will play the part of Macbeth. Lee has appeared in five major University Theater productions, and was the director of "Girl of the Golden West," which was presented last November.

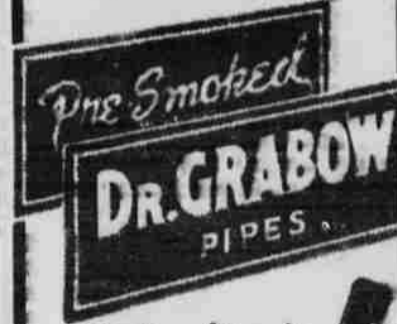
