Hurt Claims By Vets Subject to Date Ruling

The Veterans Administration explained today that to be compensable at wartime rates, death, disability or aggravation of injury upon which World War II veterans and their dependents base claims must have occurred in

service between December 7, 1941, and July 25, 1947.

Ashley Westmoreland, manager of the Lincoln VA regional office, pointed out that wartime rates are about 25 percent higher than peacetime pensions for comparable disabilities.
