Coach Ed Wier has entered five men in the 1948 Kansas relays in Lawrence Friday and Saturday. Jim McConnell left Thursday for Lawrence and will compete in the decathlon which starts Friday morning.

Al Thompson will carry the Cornhusker colors in the 100-yard dash. The Omaha athlete finished third behind Texas' Charlie Parker and Maurice Fuquay of Oklahoma A. & M. in the Texas relays two weeks ago.

Don Cooper, making his second appearance since spraining an ankle, will compete in his specialty, the pole vault. Dick Piderit is entered in the shot put, and Russ Hale will run the 400-meter low hurdle race.

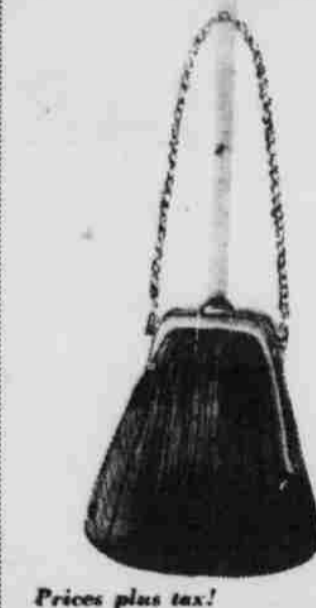
