money and specially trained teachers to develop these ideas.

Modern Ed

Modern methods and theories in educating the blind are used. The standard Braille slate is provided for writing. A special arithmetic slate with Braille symbols facilitates speed in solution of problems. It is hoped that the blind can be taught to write in long hand, and that some device for the writing of Braille

from right to left instead of the present left to right will be perfected. There is a limited number of Braille typewriters for teacher and student use. Conventional typewriters are being used as early as the third grade in an attempt to teach the blind to concentrate.

The rehabilitated blind of the past have proved the program of education to be worthwhile, and

those people have been the inspiration for new and better methods.

McMillen became superintendent of the school just one year ago. He is enthusiastic about his work, providing special education for the blind. The new philosophy of education is to fit the course of study and the methods of teaching to the individual that he may develop the best of his ability.
