## R. P. Nicholson Named NROTC Associate Prof

Cmdr. Richard P. Nicholson, USN, who formerly attended the University of Nebraska as an engineering student, is now the new associate professor of naval science in the Naval ROTC program at Nebraska.

He succeeds Cmdr. William W. Fitts who was reassigned from the university in June to duty at Saipan. Commander Nicholson, formerly

of Valentine, has seen a lot of water since he checked out of the University after three years in 1932. He was graduated from the U. S. Naval Academy in 1937 and during the war served in the submarine service.

Eventually given command of his own vessel, the Quillback, Commander Nicholson operated in the South Pacific. Included among the Quillback's successful missions was the rescue of an American aviator who was shot down in enemy waters. Prior to reporting for duty at the University, Commander Nicholson was engaged in submarine experimental work in the Atlantic.

During his student days at the University, Commander Nicholson

was a member of the Pershing Rifles and captain of the University rifle team. He is married and has a six-year-old daughter, Priscilla.

## Shinn Appointed New Director Of University YW

Ruth E. Shinn has been appointed executive director of the University YWCA, it was announced this summer by the YW advisory board.
