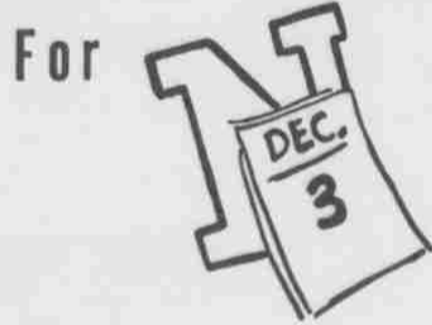
productions and is a veteran of many radio shows. He is known for his versatility on the airwaves as he has successfully acted, written, and directed for radio.
