Commissioner Donald Miller has said that 7,466 persons were reported jobless on May 1. This figure represents a drop of 42 percent in the preceding month.

Miller also said that heavy placement gains over March in the outdoor employment fields on farms and construction projects contributed largely to the drop in unemployment.

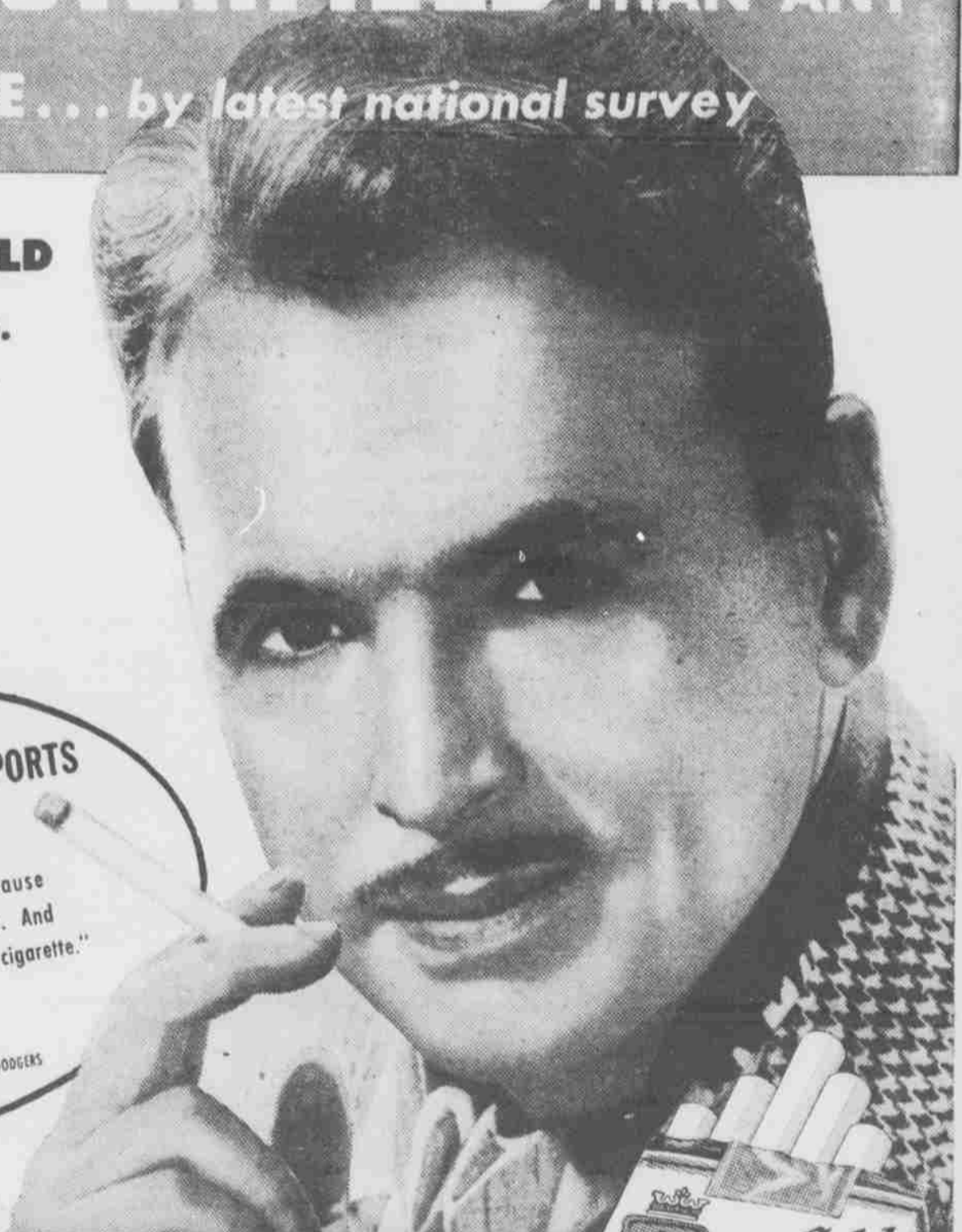
