

### Negro Tenor To Give Recital At St. Paul's

Roland Hayes, Negro tenor who has been widely applauded by professional music critics, will present a concert at St. Paul's Methodist church Nov. 21 at 8:15 p. m.

As a concert tenor, Hayes has performed to audiences throughout the world. Following his performance at Royal Albert hall and the National Art gallery in London in 1943 with Dame Myra Hess pianist, he received the plaudits of John S. Winant, then U.S. ambassador to England and Jacob L. Devers, commanding general, U.S. Army, European Theatre of Operations.

Citing his concerts as inspiring, warm, and patriotic, the Ameri-

can officials lauded Hayes' efforts in furthering Anglo-American relations and in entertaining overseas troops. Winant called the Albert hall concert the "most moving concert" he had ever attended.

Additional honors which the Negro tenor has received include: choice of Hayes as soloist with the Boston symphony orchestra by Dr. Serge Koussevitzky to sing Feb. 25 and 26, 1944, the world premiere of Grete Janinov's "Oecumenical Mass."

Max Meyer, president of the

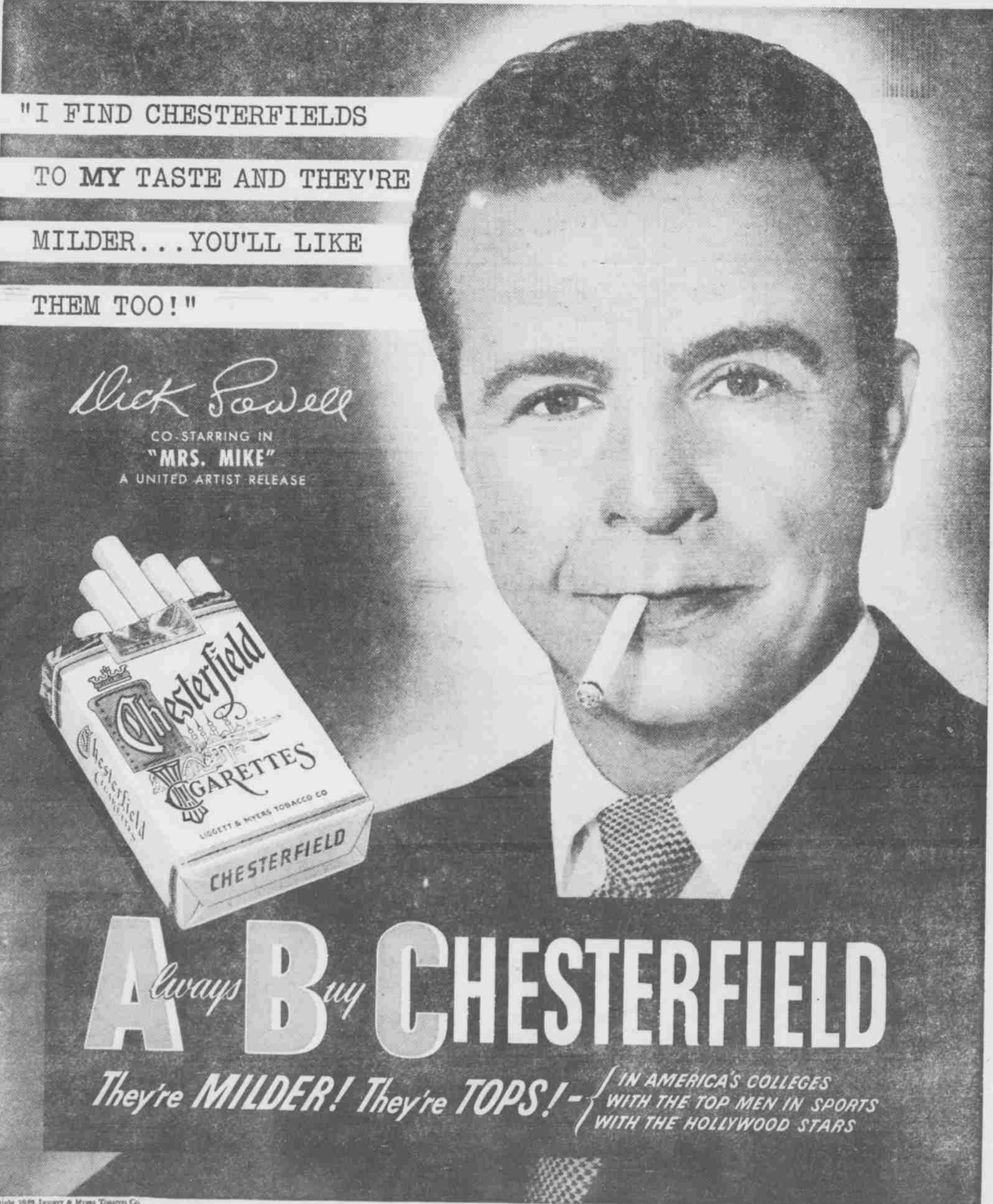
