Head Coach Harry Good said Thursday Nebraska's failure to build up a large half-time score against the Northwest Missouri Teachers was due to the lack of consistent scoring from out court.

Good indicated he would drill the squad heavily on long shots. "I definitely intend to stress shooting from out on the court before our game Monday," he said. "You must have good shooters or your under the basket game won't work," Good continued.

The Cornhusker mentor explained that an opponent will spot a team's inability to hit from the floor and drop back to protect their basket, thus stopping a "drive-in" attack.

Good was pleased by the Husker's penetration of the Teachers' defense in the second half. "I thought the boys did a more than satisfactory job in deciphering their style and holding them to four field goals in the second half," he said.
