## 420 New Students Join Fraternities

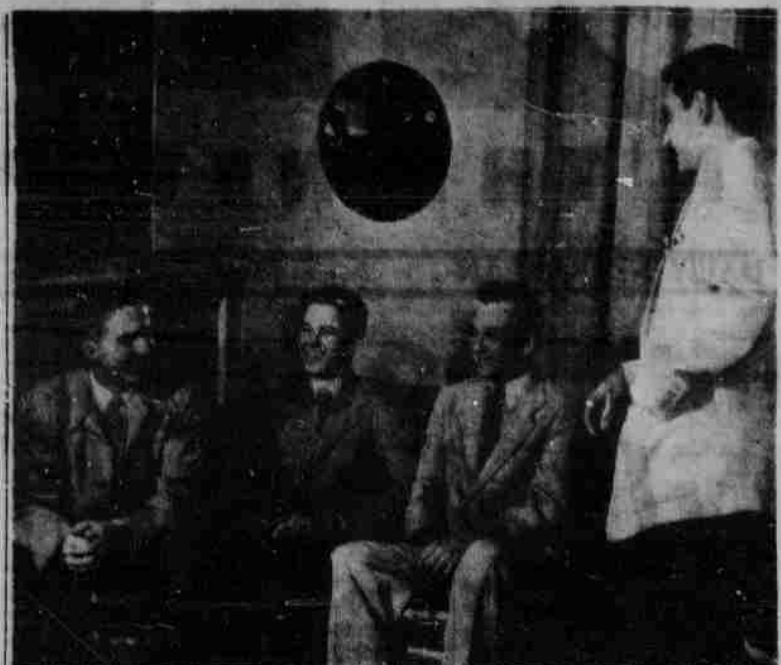

### Dr. Georgi Gets AEC Instruction

Dr. Carl E. Georgi, University professor of bacteriology, is one of 32 American scientists receiving special instruction this month at the Atomic Energy Commission's Oak Ridge, Tenn., research center.

The instruction, offered by the Oak Ridge Institute of Nuclear Studies, concerns the use of radioisotopes in research work. Radioisotopes are atoms which radiate minute electrical charges. The charges can be recorded on a Geiger counter, thus enabling research workers to trace the path of the isotopes through complicated chemical and biological processes.
