Kansas State Defeats Battered Huskers Again

The Nebraska baseball team ended one of their worst road trips in years Tuesday, suffering their fourth straight setback. The Huskers bowed before Kansas State 6-5 after being blanked by the Cats 6-0 on Monday. Earlier, Oklahoma had drubbed the Nebraska team twice in Norman.

A sensational two run homer by shortstop Don Frimmore in the bottom of the ninth inning robbed Nebraska of the win.

NU Baseball Nine Battles Colorado Team

Coach Tony Sharpe's Husker baseball team returns to their home diamond with a pair of games against Colorado University this weekend. The Scarlet meet their Big Seven foes in single contests on Friday and Saturday.

Nebraska wound up a four-game road trip against the Kansas State Wildcats in Manhattan Tuesday. The team's dreams of a Big Seven championship and an automatic bid to the College World Series in Omaha this June received a rude jolt as they dropped a pair of games to powerful Oklahoma and their contests to the Cats.

The Huskers had opened their conference campaign with an impressive pair of triumphs over the University of Kansas.

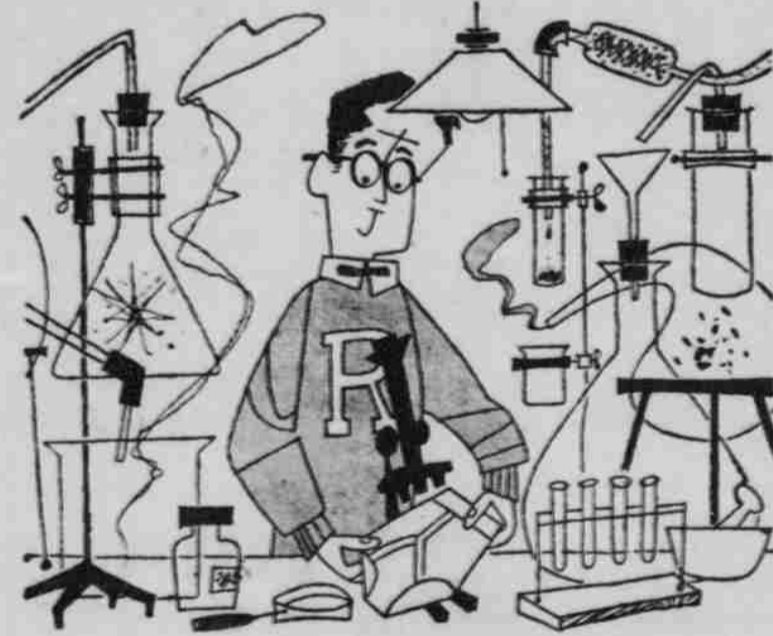
