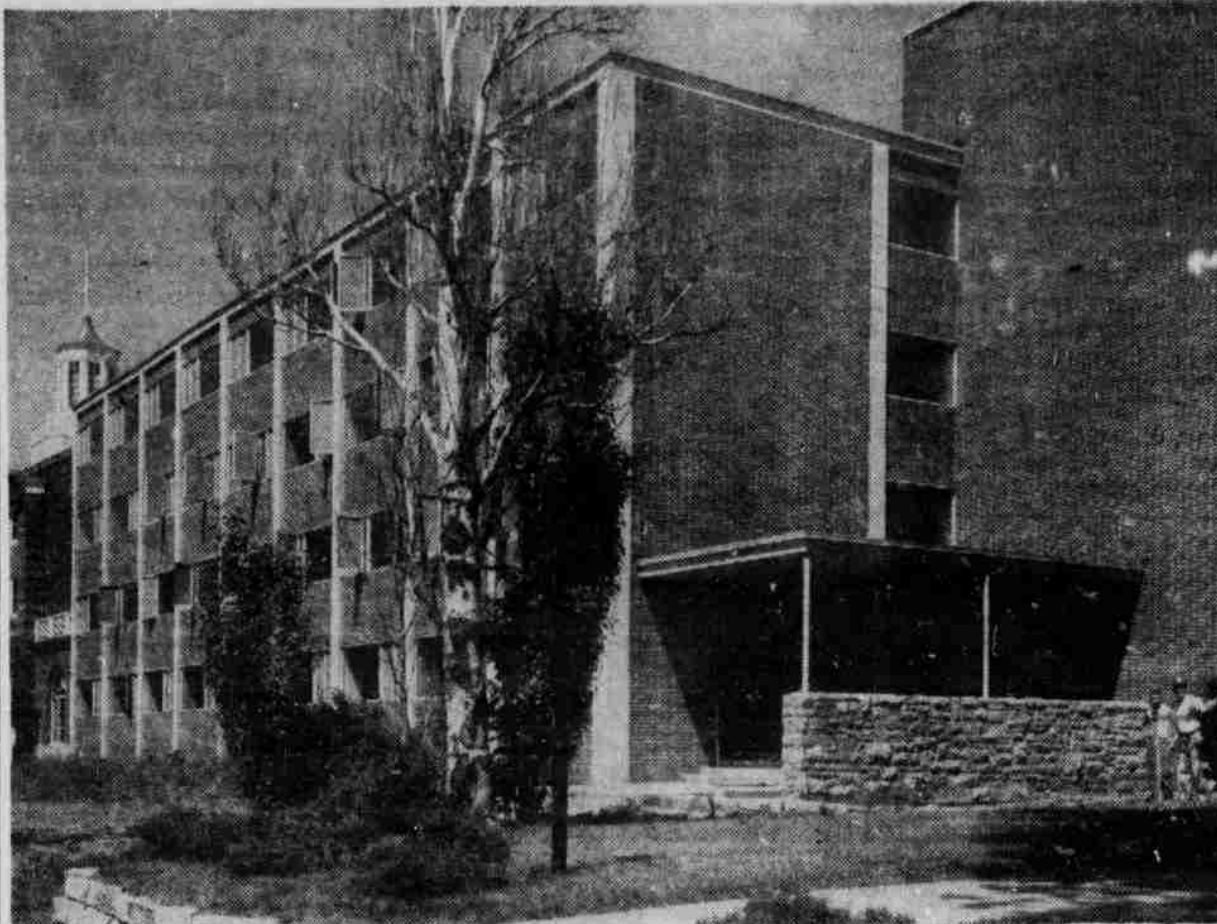

**Dorm To Open Soon**

Co-eds can expect to move into the newly dedicated Elsie Ford Piper Residence Halls some time next month, according to officials within the dorm. The \$550,000 addition to the Residence Hall was named in honor of the former dean of women at the university. Financed by revenue and not by tax funds, the four-story building—first University housing unit to go beyond three floors — will house 160 women, two to a rooms, with all the rooms air conditioned. Miss Piper, who spoke at the dedication Sunday, was a staff member of the University for 35 years. From 1925 until her retirement in 1950, she was associate dean of women. She was twice named president of the Nebraska Association of deans of women.
