KK Meetings

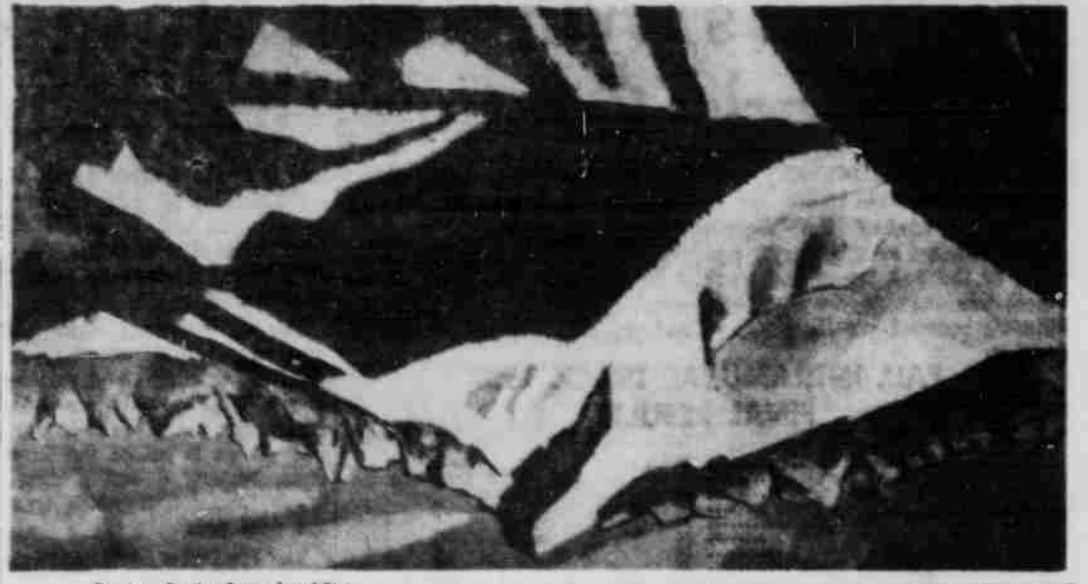
