Star Of Week:

Fitzpatrick Cited in Buff, K-State Performances

Willie Fitzpatrick, star basketball player for the Cornhuskers, has been designated as the Daily Nebraskan Star of the Week for his sparkling performance against Colorado University last Saturday and Kansas State Monday.

Fitzpatrick, who turned out to be a real find for Nebraska this season, played consistent ball against the Buffaloes in racking up 16 pts to finish the season with 264 pts. His fast surge during the past month in the point making department enabled him to tie Gary Reimers for the team scoring lead. He was the second leading team rebounder.

Willie's career as a basketball player started in Marshall, Missouri, where he was a member of a team that won the district championship in his senior year. After graduating from high school, he went to Central State College in Ohio because his coach graduated from there. He played for Central State for two years before joining the U.S. Air Force. During his three year hitch with the Airmen, he was assigned to the Lincoln AFB. Fortunately Coach Bush learned of his presence here and he encouraged him to attend Nebraska.

Fitzpatrick will long be remembered for his rebounding and ball-handling against Kansas and for his sensational exhibition of drive in shots against Kansas State.

On one occasion during the Kansas State game, he calmly drove in for a layup against three Wildcat defenders to score two points.

Willie is an amiable sort of fellow who seems to have an air of confidence about him no matter where he goes. He felt that his greatest thrills came when the Huskers defeated both Kansas and Kansas State. His tie for team scoring lead also afforded him with a great amount of satisfaction.

When asked what he thought about Nebraska's chances in basketball next year he seemed optimistic.

He simply let off one of his big flashing smiles and said: "Nebraska's chances are good, real good."
