

Lake Cools New Union

The new Student Union's greatest offer to the summer school student will be "improved and complete air conditioning," according to D. E. Lake, managing director of the Union.

The Student Union and the Administration building now share the same branch from the University power plant for air conditioning.

"We will have our own unit by next fall," Lake said.

When the new Union is completed, the Administration building will take over the presently shared power line for private air conditioning.

The expanding Student Union grew into a former parking lot that had a capacity of 300 cars, Lake said. When the Union is finished "78 cars can park on the lot," he stated.

Plant for expansion started about two years ago, Lake said. The "philosophy for expansion was to improve our design so we could be of more service," he said.

Included in the features of the new Student Union will be a small auditorium, a computer's lunch area, a barber shop, a fountain lounge to replace the "Crib," three music rooms, two party rooms ("for hour dances," Lake said), ten bowling alleys and 12 billiard tables.

The style of architecture for the new Union is "modified modern," according to Lake.
