Beginning July 14. KUON-TV will broadcast a threeweek course in remedial English for next fall's incoming freshmen showing weaknesses in English.

University entrance exam inations are given in the spring to Lincoln high school students and also in the summer to those who wish to avail themselves of it then. English deficiencies are determined from these examinations.

According to Lee W. Chatfield, director of Junior Division, incoming freshmen scheduled to take the noncredit course, English A, will be encouraged to take the televised course. Successful completion of the course will qualify students for English B. a credit course.

Mrs. Helen Graham, supervisor of English A, will teach the course at 7 p.m. Monday through Friday over Channel

Robert Schlater, assistant producer-director of educational television, said, "Nationally there is a great deal of experimentation in educational television. Studies have shown that television-taught students do as well, and in most cases, somewhat better than the student in the normal classroom situation.


