Hersch set a Nebraska single season scoring record with 428 points to lead the Huskers scoring. He also set a Nebraska record for most field goals in a single game with 14 against Detroit. Turn er led the Huskers in rebounding with 244. His closest competitor in this department was Maxey with 179.

Another record which Turner will undoubtedly erase next year is the three-season scoring record of 854 held by Rex Ekwall. Hersch has a twoyear total of 674 and needs only 181 points his senior year to set the record.

Turner thinks the Huskers will be better next year. He says, "I think we will be vast-ly improved. We will have more heighth and more bench strength, something which has been lacking the past two


