

# Husker Nine Will Test Missouri's Win String

Nebraska's baseball team will get a chance to see just how good Missouri is this weekend in a three game series at Columbia. Missouri is currently in second place in the Big Eight standings with a 3-0 record and Nebraska is holding down the third spot with a 2-1 mark.

If Ken Ruisinger's back has mended he will probably get the starting call for Friday's nine inning game. Ruisinger has been bothered by a pinched nerve in his back. He sat out the first game against Iowa State last weekend but got into the doubleheader, Saturday.

If Ruisinger pitches Friday, then Harry Tolly and Enlowe "Lefty" Hevner will take the mound for Saturday's two 7-inning contests. Hevner pitched a one-hitter and Tolly gave up only four hits as the Huskers took a doubleheader from Iowa State last Saturday by identical scores of 2-1.

Missouri's scheduled series with Kansas last week was cancelled because of bad weather. The Tigers hold 3-0, 26-3, and 22-0 victories over Kansas State in their only Big Eight competition. Missouri has an overall record of 9-0.

Ken Ruisinger and LeRoy Zentic are leading the Husker regulars in hitting with .333 marks. Dave Murakami is the only other Nebraska regular hitting over .300 with a .308 average. Ely Churchich and Dick Nelson are crowding the .300 mark with .290 and .286 respectively.

# Nebraska's Jamaican Jet To Race In Drake Relays

The flashy "Jamaican Jet," Keith Gardner, whose brilliant track career at Nebraska ended last season, will be

pounding the cinders again this weekend at the Drake Relays.

Gardner, who set records ranging in inclusiveness from the Big Eight conference to the world, has expended his intercollegiate eligibility; he will be running unattached. His event will be the 100-yard dash.

The friendly, mustached speedster from Kingston, Jamaica set Big Eight marks in the 120-yard high hurdles and 220-yard dash last season. He won the Henry F. Schulte award for being the outstanding performer in the Big Eight track meet, and was named Daily Nebraskan "Athlete of the Year."

Last summer, Keith toured Europe with the Jamaican track team, which he has captained since 1955. The team competed in Sweden, Finland and England, took part in the British Empire Games in Cardiff, Wales, and then visited Ireland and Scotland, concluding the tour with a return trip to Sweden.

During the two-month tour, Keith ran in 46 races. He won all but six, in which he finished second. He set a European record for the 100-yard dash, with a time of 9.4 sec-

# Sevigne Names Six NU Tracksters For Relays

Track coach Frank Sevigne named Knolly Barnes, Bill Melody, Joe American Horse, Joe Mullins, Ken Ash and Ken Pollard to perform in the Drake Relays at Des Moines today and tomorrow.

Barnes, Melody, American Horse and Mullins will run in the four-mile relay Friday. This foursome was second in the Texas Relays with a 17:18 clocking. American Horse set a Nebraska record in the two-mile run Tuesday against Houston and Kansas State with a time of 9:27.5.

Mullins won the mile Tuesday with American Horse in third place. Mullins time was 4:11.4 and American Horse was close behind in 4:12.6.

Nebraska will run in the two-mile relay Saturday with the same quartet mentioned above probably teaming up again although Ken Ash may

replace one of them. The Huskers were second in this event at the Kansas Relays finishing on the heels of the winning Jayhawks.

Joe Mullins may run in the open mile Saturday. The race is scheduled after the two mile relay and Sevigne believes there will be enough time to give Mullins the needed rest.

Ken Pollard will compete in the pole vault for the Huskers. He vaulted 13-6 Tuesday to win against K-State and Houston.
