## Grant Given

A grant of $\$ 11,730$ has been received by two fullime faculty members at the University of Nebraska College of Medicine in Omaha.
Sponsored by the National Heart Institute of the National Institutes of Health, the funds will aid in the study of cardiac action of rhodochlorin on warm-blooded animals. The chemical has previously been used in experimental rescarch at the college on frog hearts, and it is hoped that this chlorophyll deriva-
