Nebraska travels to Missouri and Colorado before ending the season with the Conference meet at Lawrence, Kansas, November 7. Gail Hodgson of Oklahoma, last year's champion will be returning to defend his crown.

He was a wingback and end on the Oklahoma teams of 1938-'39-'40. Bill is the twenty-fourth University of Nebraska head football coach since the first full-time mentor was hired in 1893.

### Nebraska Football Team Has Four Native Texans

Four Texas natives will be playing on the Nebraska side of the scrimmage line when the Huskers open their seventieth season against Texas, Saturday.

The Texans are Centers Darrel Cooper and Bill Bohanan. End Dick McDaniel and Quarterback Dean Cozine. Bohanan was switched to center the past weekend when an injury forced sophomore Mick Tingelhoff to the sidelines.

Bohanan came to Nebraska as a back from

Navarro (Tex.) Junior College where he won all-conference honors as the league's outstanding back. He was moved to the end position when Nebraska needed ends last fall.

Cooper, a 217-pounder was named to the all-Southwest conference freshman team before transferring to Nebraska after his freshman year at Baylor.

Cozine played his high school football with R. L. Paschal High in Fort Worth lettering in both basketball and football. Paschal High was district champion in 1955 and 1956.

Injuries sidelined him last fall but he was voted the outstanding back in the annual alumni-varsity game last spring.

Bohanan, McDaniel and Cooper were members of the Lincoln Police department during the summer.

### Klaas Is New NU Swim Coach

The newest addition to the Nebraska coaching staff is Richard "Dick" Klaas who replaces Hollie Lepley as swimming coach. Lepley resigned last spring.

Klaas was an assistant swimming coach and physical education teacher at the University of Colorado prior to coming to Nebraska. He graduated from Iowa State Teachers College in 1953 and received his Masters Degree from the University of Colorado in 1955.

Dick coached basketball at Cedar Falls (Ia.) Teachers High School for one year before going to Colorado for his Masters.

Co-Captains of this year's swimming team are Frank Tomson and Ron Bucklin. Tomson competes in the

backstroke and Bucklin performs in the individual medley, breaststroke and butterfly.

#### Lettermen

Other returning lettermen and their specialties are Roger Bosveld, freestyle; Larry McClean, butterfly; Joe Stocker, breaststroke; Dale Voss, freestyle and Branch Walton, diver. Tomson and Bucklin are seniors and the rest juniors.

Sophomores being counted on are Jim Frank and Jay

Smith, divers; Kuni Mihara, distance freestyle; Jim Pickett; freestyle; Myron Papadakis, breaststroke and Larry Farrell, backstroke.

A meeting will be held October 2 for those interested in varsity or freshman swimming and workouts will begin about October 15.

Klaas' swimmers will open the season December 17 against Kansas State in the Coliseum pool. Last year, the Nebraska swimming team finished fifth in the Big Eight.

### STUDENT UNION BOWLING, BILLIARDS and TABLE TENNIS

Your Nebraska Union Games Area in its desire to serve the greatest number of people at a moderate price has installed this price policy regarding Bowling, Billiards and Table Tennis. We felt that this price structure will be a great advantage to the students, faculty, alumni and staff participating in this area during our operation schedule of 9:AM until the building closes.

In bowling, the rate of \$2.45 per hour per lane, regardless of the number of players, has been determined with the knowledge that the Brunswick-Automatic Pinspotter will set 8 lines per hour without any undue haste.

Your time charge will start when you check out a bowling sheet at the control desk. We would recommend that you put on your shoes and select a ball prior to checking out a lane. Should there be any break down of the machine on your lane, your card will be punched out at the time of stoppage and punched in again when the machine goes back into action. This will be credited against your time charge. In order to report a stoppage of the machine or trouble on the lanes, report it to the desk attendant. We will have telephones installed on the tele-scores within the next two weeks, and these will be used to report your trouble to the control desk.

If you desire a new rack of pins, there is a "New Pin" button located on the side of the ball stop.

Brunswick Automatic Pinspotters have been installed in our new Game Area along with their complete line of equipment. This will provide a continuous service throughout the year.

We know that you will enjoy bowling with them because of the rhythm that is set for you and with the machine perfected as it is, we know that your scoring should improve.

In Billiards, the rate of 60c per hour per table has been established. There is no limit to the number of players to a table. We have five Rotation Billiard Tables, Five Snooker Billiards Tables, and Two Carom or Straight Rail Tables.

In Table Tennis, the rate is 30c per hour per table. We have six tables available for your use.

If you desire instructions in any of these areas, please ask the Desk attendant. Instruction is given to you without extra cost, however, you will be expected to pay the regular rate for the use of these games.

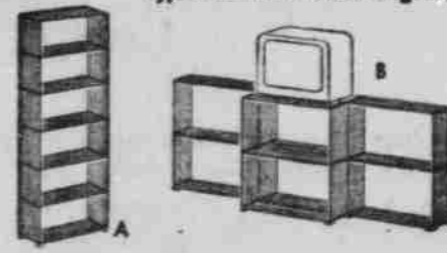

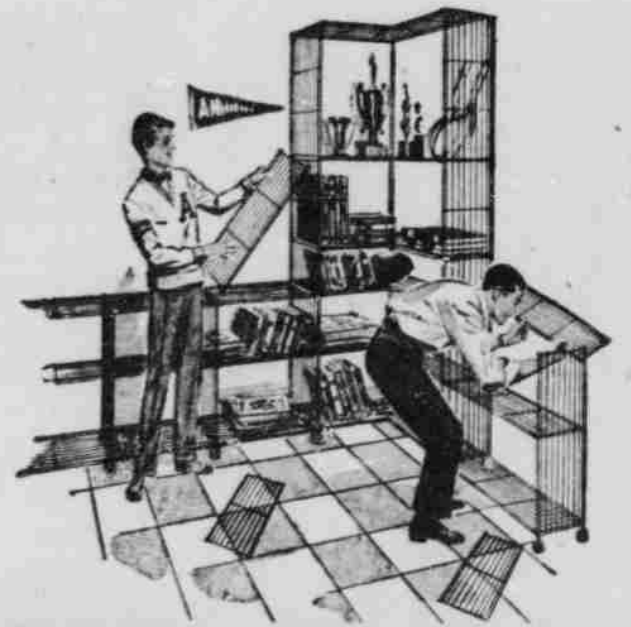

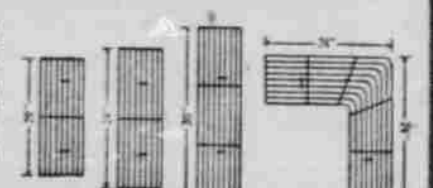
