## Colorado Aerial Artist



SOPHOMORE QUARTERBACK — Gale Weidner, a 19-year-old sophomore quarterback, has led Colorado to upset wins over Missouri and Kansas the past two Saturdays. Weidner will give the Huskers' pass defense a stern test when the two teams meet in a Parents Day game in Memorial Stadium Saturday.

## Weidner and Soergel Lead Big 8 Passers

Colorado sophomore Gale Weidner completed 10 of 17 passes against Kansas Saturday to narrow the gap between he and Oklahoma State's Dick Soergel in the Big Eight passing department. Conference statistics show Soergel leading with 83 completions on 136 attempts for 997 yards. Weidner has attempted 146 passes and completed 75 for 943 yards. Weidner has had eleven passes intercepted while only three of Soergel's tosses have been pirated.

**Rushing Leader**  
Tom Watkins of Iowa State continues to lead the rushers with 707 yards on 127 carries for an average of 5.6 yards per carry. Teammate Dwight Nichols is second with 605 yards in 172 carries. Nebraska's Pat Fischer leads the punt returners with a 17.9 yard average per return. Fischer has returned seven punts for 125 yards. Bobby Boyd of Oklahoma is second in punt returns with seven returns for 116 yards. John Hadl of Kansas leads the punters by a wide margin. He has a 45.9 yard average as compared to Kansas State's John Solmos with a second place average of 38.5 yards. Harry Tolly of Nebraska is the fifth leading punter with 37.4 yards per punt. Tolly is the league's busiest punter with 43 punts.

# Home Finale for Eleven

## Win Would Give NU Best Season Since '56

Saturday's game against Colorado will be the final home game for 11 seniors on the Husker football team and a win would assure Nebraska of its best record since 1956. The 11 seniors are quarterbacks Harry Tolly and Tom Kramer; halfback Carroll "Pappy" Zaruba; fullback Bill Bohannon; ends Max Martz, Roger Brede and Guy Sapp; guards Dale Siemer and LeRoy Zentic; tackle Duane Mongerson and center Jim Moore. Kramer has been sidelined with an injury and Sapp has yet to see action.

**3-5 Record**  
Nebraska is 1-3 in the conference and 3-5 overall. Victories in the final two games of the season against Colorado and Kansas State would give the Huskers their best record since 1954 when Bill Glassford's squad went to the Orange Bowl with a 5-5 record.

One win in the last two games would give Head Coach Bill Jennings his best record since taking over the head duties. In his first year, Nebraska won one and lost nine. Last year, they finished with a 3-7 record. Nebraska went through a
