Kansas Relay Is First Test for NU Swimmers

Nebraska's swimming team in their first season under the direction of Dick Klaas opens the season Saturday in the Kansas Relays at Lawrence.

Klaas announced a 13-man traveling squad including seven lettermen. Those making the trip are Don Benson, Joe Bonnemeier, Roger Bosveld, Ron Bucklin, Larry Ferrell, Jim Frank, Larry McClean,

Kuni Mihara, Myron Papadakis, Jay Smith, Joe Stocker, Frank Tomson and Branch Walton.

Colorado, Kansas and Kansas State are the other teams in the meet. "Kansas should win it since they have their strongest team in history and the others will fight it out for second," said Klaas. "Everyone is stronger except Nebraska," he continued.

Wrestlers Face OU Tonight

Nebraska's sophomore-studded wrestling team opens the season tonight against Oklahoma at Norman and travel to Stillwater Saturday to meet Oklahoma State.

Nine of the ten wrestlers making the trip are sophomores. Drawing opening assignments against the Sooners will probably be Ted Rethmeier, 123-lbs.; Phil Johnson, 130-lbs.; Wayne Reeve, 137-lbs.; Jim Faimon, 147-lbs.; Gene Tice, 157-lbs.; Bruce O'Callaghan, 167-lbs.; Roland Wallick, 177-lbs.; and Jim Raschke, heavyweight.

Others making the trip are Garry Harley, an 157-pounder and Jim Anderson, an 147-pounder. Rethmeier is the only upperclassman on the squad.

Gregg Doubtful Oklahoma, a third place finisher in last year's NCAA meet, will probably be without the services of their top 147-pounder, Jay Gregg. Gregg defeated Ken Hecht of Colorado Mines 10-4 in his opening match Dec. 4.

The Sooners defeated Colorado Mines 29-3. Their probable wrestlers against the Huskers are Gerald Whitfield, 123-lbs.; Duwayne Miller, 130-lbs.; Stanley Abel, 137-lbs.; Lawrence Gregory, 147-lbs.; Ray Johnson, 157-lbs.; Sid Terry, 167-lbs.; David Campbell, 177-lbs.; and Dale Lewis, heavyweight.

Abel was last year's NCAA champion at 130 pounds and Terry was a NCAA runner-up at 157 pounds. Lewis was a Pan-American heavyweight champion in Olympic style wrestling.

Oklahoma State, Saturday night's opponent, is the defending NCAA champion.

The Phi Delta Theta 200-yard free style relay team composed of Robin Snider, Stan Wilson, Charles Wilson and Jim Frank set a new record in that event with a 1:50.5 clocking. The old record was set by Beta Theta Pi at 1:51.1 in 1957.
