Stewart Air Force, the Air Force Academy and Minnesota while Notre Dame has a 4-1 record with a three-game winning streak.

The Irish opened the season with a 77-59 triumph over Western Illinois and then lost to Michigan State 61-56 in an overtime battle.

Notre Dame coach Johnny Jordan has seven returning lettermen but lost the top scorer in Notre Dame history from last year's team in Tom Hawkins.

Hawkins scored 1,820 points in three seasons and holds the single season scoring mark of 730 points.

Team Captain Mike Greaney leads the list of returning monogram winners which in-

cludes John Tully, William Noonan, Emmett McCarthy, William Crosby, Robert Bradtkie and Michael Bekelja.

The Irish will probably start an all-veteran lineup with Graney and McCarthy at forwards, Tully in the pivot and Crosby and Bradtkie handling the backcourt assignments.

Notre Dame uses a double pivot offense with Tully and Graney playing the key roles. Tully is a 6-7, 210-pound, junior from New York City.

He led the Irish in their 67-52 victory over the Air Force Academy Saturday night with 16 points and he also pulled down 14 rebounds.

Graney, the other half of the double pivot, will also tower over the Huskers. He stands 6-5 and tips the scales at 225 pounds.

He teams with John Tully, 6-7, in the Irish double pivot offense. Graney scored 13 points in Notre Dame's 67-52 win over the Air Force Academy Saturday night.

The Notre Dame starting lineup will average just under six feet four inches. In addition to Tully and Graney, McCarthy is 6-3, Crosby is 6-4 and Bradtkie is the short man at 6-1.

Graney was the second leading scorer for Notre Dame last year with a 10.3 average and Tully was fifth with an 8.7 point average.

Graney led the team in rebounds with 337 while Tully was fourth with 131 as the

Irish finished last season a 12-13 record, identical to the Huskers.

Nebraska coach Jerry Bush will probably go along with the same lineup that started the last two games for the Huskers.

This will find Al Maxey (6-3) and Jim Kowalke (6-3) at forwards; Bob Harry (6-6) at center with Rex Swett (6-1) and Hersch Turner (6-1 1/2) at guards.

After the first three games, Turner leads the Nebraska scoring parade with 53 points for a 17.7 point average. Maxey is right behind Turner with a 15.7 average followed by Kowalke with 7.6, Harry and Swett each with a 5.7 average.

A preliminary game will pit the freshmen with a 2-1 record against a group of Husker football players.

The Tigers posted victories over Washington (Mo.), Arkansas and Indiana. They entertain Wisconsin tonight and Rice Thursday night and then travel to Minnesota for an encounter with the Gophers Saturday.

Oklahoma suffered their first defeat of the season Saturday night, 59-57, to Minnesota. The Sooners had previous victories over Texas

Western, Hardin-Simmons and Texas Tech.
