

## Thornton Sets Pace For Nebraska Rushers

Thunder Thornton continues ing plays and trail in total completions in seven attempts to lead the Huskers in rushing yardage 659-495.

Ron Meade leads the Nebraska passers with four rushing yardage stands up in 157 yards on 32 carries for a 4.9 average.

Pat Clare moved into second place in the average vardage figures ahead of Clay White. Clare has carried the ball nine times for 34 yards or an average of 3.3 yards per carry. White has carried the same number of times but has gained one less yard for a 3.7 average.

In total vards rushing Pat Fischer is second with 122 yards on 34 carries for a 3.6 average. Fischer leads the team in number of carries.

Nebraska leads its opponents in rushing average with 3.5 yards to 3.4 yards for the three opponents. But the Huskers have had 52 fewer rush-




