Nebraska's cross country team finished second in a triangular meet with Colorado State University and Colorado at Boulder, Saturday.

CSU placed first with 19 points, Nebraska followed with 47, and Colorado was last with 55.

Ray Stevens finished third over the windy three mile course in 16:10. Bill Kenny came in 8th, Clarence Scott 11th, Rich Kier 12th, Joe Scott 13th, and Paul Nielsen 15th.

The Huskers will host Missouri this weekend in the last home meet.

Woody Moore tied for ninth with Tomni Coane in 10:03. Jim Lewis of Nebraska finished 11th in 10:12 and Andy Steele finished 12th for the Huskers with 10:12.4.
